

Theme:

Removal of rep programming, but being careful to continue to encourage association kids to strive for representative programs.

Constitution

Changes to:

Article 3 – Registered Office – no need for centre point for local league organization

Article 5 - Team Names, Colours, and Logo – remove rep team being called Aylmer Flames

Article 6 - Association Affiliation – remove SCMHA

By-Laws

Changes to:

By-Law 1:– Board of Directors – removal of SCMHA rep.

By-Law 2: Responsibilities of the Board of Directors – remove reference to level of play (rep).; slight change to OMHA Rep forms (requirements to sign), ice convenor does not correspond with SCMHA rep; removal of SCMHA rep.

By-Law 6: Additional Committees – removal of rep teams from coach selection committee; need to think about slight revision of role of registration committee regarding player movement from rep to local or vice versa

By-Law 7: Insurance – increase liability insurance from \$2 million to \$5 million

By-Law 8: Players – refer to Aylmer as local league centre only; players may affiliate with same division Rep organization (purposefully not named)

By-Law 9: Eligibility to Play in a Higher Division – player to indicate interest in playing at a higher division at the time of registration; call tryouts – “pre-skates”; remove SCMHA; switch “a team roster is released” with “submitted for approval”.

By-Law 11: General Rules and Regulations – waive registration fees Aylmer hosted tournaments and jamborees; keep international Silver Stick, eliminate min requirements for rep team; eliminate bus; eliminate rep player release;

By-Law 13: OMHA Playdowns – whole section not needed

By-Law 14: Honourary Life Membership – eliminate member per October 2023
